

George Harmon Ferguson



CMSgt. (retired) George Harmon Ferguson, age 82, of Wichita Falls, Texas, formerly of Biloxi, Mississippi, died Sunday, June 27, 2010, in Wichita Falls.

Memorial Services were held at 10:00 a.m. Friday, July 2, 2010 at Royal Estates of Wichita Falls, officiated by Chaplain Keith Jenkins. Graveside services and interment will follow at a later date in the Biloxi National Cemetery in Biloxi, Mississippi.

George was born June 20, 1928, in East Liverpool, Ohio, to William Thomas Ferguson and Mary (Knowles) Ferguson. He married Hildegard (Ronge), January 5, 1950, in Landsberg am Lech, Germany.

George enlisted in the Air Force in January, 1946, and served his country for thirty years before retiring in 1977. His assignments while working for HQ GEEIA (communications) took him all over the world before settling in Biloxi where he worked an additional ten years in civil service. George remained active with the GEEIA group after retirement, attending many functions and reunions.
