Joseph Francis Quirk II, age 66, of Camdenton, Missouri, departed this life on Wednesday January 15, 2014, at his residence in Camdenton.

Joseph was born May 9, 1947 in China Lake, California, the son of Joseph and Elizabeth (Delsordo) Quirk.

Joseph was united in marriage to JoAnne Rooks in Las Vegas, Nevada in 1977, and together they shared 36 years of marriage until his death.

Joseph graduated from Van Nuys High School in 1965.
